### **Membership Secretary's report**

The period since the last AGM has seen a growth in both institutional and individual membership of ALDinHE, with now a total of 54 institutions represented in the Association.

As reported at the 2008 AGM, the first year of membership officially commenced on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2007 and has been extended until Spring 2009 to coincide with the annual ALDinHE symposium. It was agreed by the ALDinHE steering group that individual membership will be combined with future symposium fees. This will confer automatic individual membership on all who attend ALDinHE symposia from 2009 onwards, with existing non-attending members invited to continue membership by payment of the appropriate fee.

Institutions will be invited to renew membership following the annual symposium and issued with a certificate of membership to confirm membership of ALDinHE. Institutional membership will continue to allow two members of that institution to attend the annual symposium at membership rate.

It should be noted that in the proposal for the continuation of the work of the Learning Higher Centre of Excellence of Teaching and learning as part of ALDinHE, that the institutional membership fee will be raised in order to support increased generation of learning development research and resources. This increase will be discussed by the ALDinHE steering group in consultation with the ALDinHE membership.
